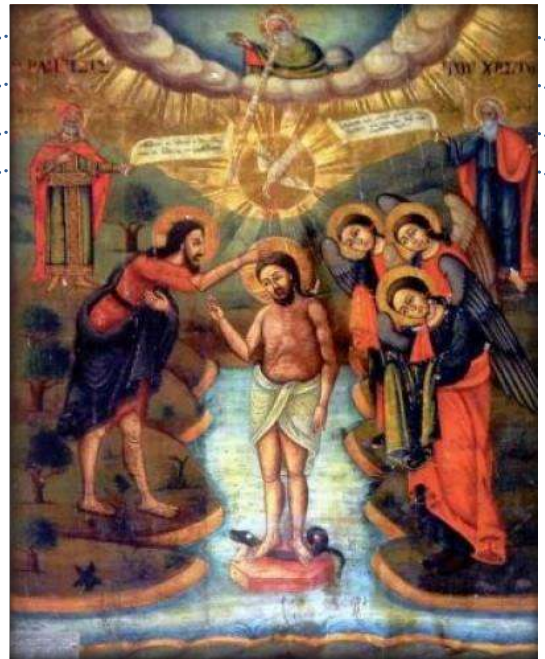

SUPPORT ORPHANAGES and HOME of HOPE



Our parish for few years now has been a big supporter of the Orphanages in Ukraine, to which two years ago we added the Home of Hope, which is a home for girls over age of 16, who are not eligible to stay at the orphanages any more.

Collected monetary donations are given to the sisters of St. Joseph, who run these facilities and use these donations to purchase the most necessary things that children need.

Because of the recent war situation, many children were left without parents and/or immediate family. Sisters are trying to provide for those children as well and, even though many of them do not live in orphanages, as its capacities are limited and filled up.

As we approach the Christmas season, for which we say it's the season of giving as a reminder of God's gift and complete giving of His Son to us, let us also give from ourselves completely, both to God and those who are most in need and less fortunate.

This is a special reminder for Christmas action, but our parish will continue to support this project even after, as it has done so till now. Our Social Justice Committee, together with Youth of both our parishes in Regina, are preparing a **FUNDRAISER DANCE on MARCH 2, 2019, FOR ORPHANAGES IN UKRAINE AND HOME OF HOPE.** Please, mark this in your calendar and come and support this project.

The night will consist of a wonderful meal, entertainment by Tavria Ukrainian Dance Ensemble and School, 50/50, silent auction and we will all then dance the night away with music by the Polka Dots from Saskatoon, SK.

All the proceeds from the evening will be going to the Lubov Home of Hope in Lviv, Ukraine and the Orphanages in Ukraine.

Hope of Hope provides 22 young women the chance at post-secondary education, and the opportunity to learn all of the life skills they will require. Some of these young women are released from the orphanages at age 16 with nowhere to go, and only a high school education. The Sister Saints of Mary Immaculate run this home and give these women a bright future.

The Sisters of St. Joseph in Saskatoon, SK run these **orphanage facilities** and use the donations to purchase the necessary things these children need. Many children are left orphaned due to the recent war situation in eastern Ukraine. The sisters are trying to provide for these children as well; even though many of them do not live in orphanages as they are already at capacity.

Tickets are \$40 for adults, \$20 for children (ages 5-12) and free for children under the age of 5. Ticket deadline is SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 24TH and can be purchased from Lesia at 306-551-3575, Katrina at 306-550-5098 or Maggie at 306-586-4157.

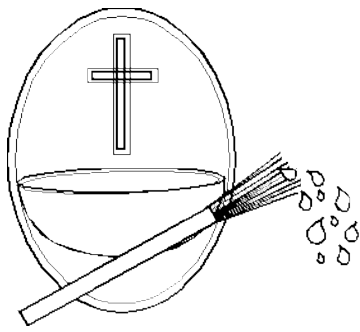

**BLESSING – MEANING AND
HOW IT HAPPENS**

With words 'House Blessing' many Catholics of Slavic tradition, both Byzantine and Roman, mean the arrival of a priest and the prayer of Christmas in families and households. It would probably be more appropriate and meaningful to use the term 'Family Blessing' but among people the term 'blessing of houses' is used commonly. We know what the name and the words 'house blessing' mean: the arrival of the priest into house, meeting with members of the household and prayer for God's blessing.

House Blessing and visitation of families have a deep meaning, sense of connection, a pleasant and friendly encounter.

The word 'to bless' has a gentle meaning. In Latin 'benedicte' (bene – good; dicte – say) has an appropriate translation into most of the Slavic languages, and so in Ukrainian; *благословити* (*blahoslovyty*) that is composed of two words, *blahyj* – dear, good, gentle, and *slovo*

– *word*. Both have a good basis for reflection, a meaning of creating a good relationship with God and with people.

It is nice when we address each other nicely, kindly, benevolently, gently... Whenever is someone approaching us gently and graciously, we pay him respect, kindness, sympathy, affection, forgiveness, love, mercy; we do not wish him any harm.

It also has a meaning when we talk about somebody: to talk nicely, with great affection and attention, evaluating one's virtues and merits. Watch out for each other.

The blessing is more than all of this, because everything that has been said above, God makes for man. A man may say, but not preform into action. God does not act like that: God does what he says, His word is action.

The priest comes to the family, comes as a person, he wants to be with his own, but he also comes in the name of God, he comes in the name of the Church.

Priest comes to the house, the family gathers around the table (or other place) where the candle and the cross is, and other symbols placed on the occasion of Christmas in their home. It brings together the community, the church in small, the Church of God is being gathered in the family home, domestic church, and they pray for all members, present and absent, invoking the blessing for the family, for all goods they possess, for the workplace and their jobs, source of food, for economic and material well-being, health, presence of the Holy Spirit in all its members and good relationships with each other and the neighbour, which is manifested through love and mercy. Who would not gather and prayed for this purpose? When the priest comes to your place of dwelling, when he approaches your home, you also come near for the gathering and the prayer of blessing.
